Dominican Republic extends state of emergency for an additional 17 days

Through decree 148-20, President Danilo Medina ordered the following measures regarding the state of emergency established to address with the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic:

ARTICLE 1. The state of emergency is extended throughout the national territory for a period of seventeen (17) days starting from April 14, 2020, pursuant to the authorization granted by the National Congress through Resolution no. 63-20 of April 11, 2020.

ARTICLE 2. The Executive Power will continue to render periodic reports to the bicameral commission of the National Congress that, by mandate of Resolution no. 62-20, was established to follow up on the actions, measures and provisions adopted during the period of this state of emergency, in accordance with the provisions of article 266, number 2, of the Constitution and article 29 of the Law no. 21-18.
