#### **Dominican Republic will maintain curfew until April 30**

With decree 151-20, President Danilo Medina ordered the following measures regarding the curfew and social distancing established to address the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic:

ARTICLE 1. The social distancing measures adopted by the Executive Power on March 17 of this year remain in force until Thursday, April 30 of the current year, as well as the additional measures that the High-Level Commission for the Prevention and Containment of the Coronavirus has implemented to address the state of emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic.

ARTICLE 2. The 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. curfew will be extended throughout the national territory until Thursday, April 30, 2020.

ARTICLE 3. We urge the population follow the social distancing measures recommended by the authorities and by the specialized organizations, and, therefore, not to leave their homes unless it is for strictly necessary purposes.
