COVID-19 (coronavirus) - Recent News 19

Dominican Republic: measures concerning the use of masks and the curfew starting on July 21

With decree 266-20, President Danilo Medina ordered the following measures regarding the use of masks and the curfew, starting on July 21 and extending for a period of twenty (20) days:

The mandatory use of masks in public places and in private places for public use is ratified as an essential measure to control the spread of COVID-19, and non-compliance will be sanctioned according to the General Health Law number 42-01.

A curfew is established from Monday through Friday from 7:00 p.m. to 5 a.m. and Saturdays and Sundays from 5:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. in the following regions:
