#### MEASURES FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF HEALTH RISK IN TOURISM

- 1. Travelers will not have to present evidence of COVID-19 to enter the Dominican Republic.**  
You do not need to bring a COVID-19 test or go through massive testing to enter the country. This ensures that the available tests are used by those who need them most.
- 2. Each tourist who stays in a hotel will have a temporary insurance covered 100% by the Dominican Government.**  
This insurance will include coverage for emergencies, long-term lodging, flight change costs and telemedicine services. The Dominican Government will use "Seguros Reserva" services to make this measure viable until December 2020.
- 3. All hotels will have a Sanitary Bubble, a robust protocol for the management of positive cases and the patient's relatives.**  
The Health Bubble is an area prepared for the management of health risk with trained doctors, associated with nearby laboratories that prioritize tourists' cases. Rapid tests will be available for relatives and companions of the possible infected person, as well as rooms for preventive quarantine and recreation areas with special hours for this group.
- 4. A protocol will be presented for suppliers, contractors, and employees entering and leaving hotels, along with constant testing.**
- 5. The use of masks and distancing will be essential during the stay in the country.**
- 6. Adjustment of labor regulations in order to minimize and mitigate risks to employees.**
- 7. Management of statistics and information related to tests applied and infections in tourist areas to have an effective control of cases.**
