Curfew remains in force for an additional 15 days in the Dominican Republic

Through Decree 142-20, the Executive Power of the Dominican Republic dictates the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. All social distancing measures adopted by the Executive Power on March 17 of this year, as well as all the social distancing measures adopted by the Executive Power on March 17 of this year, and the additional measures implemented by the High-Level Commission for the Prevention and Control of the Coronavirus in response to the emergency situation created by the COVID-19 pandemic, remain in force for an additional term of fifteen (15) days,

ARTICLE 2. Starting on Friday, April 3 of the current year, the curfew established by Decree no. 135-20, of March 20, 2020, and its modifications, from 5:00 p.m. at 6:00 a.m., will be extended for fifteen (15) days throughout the national territory.

ARTICLE 3. The population is advised to observe the social distancing measures recommended by the authorities and by the specialized organizations, and, therefore, not to leave their homes unless for strictly necessary purposes.

ARTICLE 4. Send this decree to the Ministry of Defense, the Ministry of the Interior and Police, and the National Police for their knowledge and execution.
